CDT's, Therapists and Hygienists Role in Oral Medicine

This afternoon lecture course has been designed specifically for all DCP team members with a clinical role. The lecture will provide an overview of the common oral medicine conditions seen in general dental practice. - Common red and white oral lesions and how they are managed

- Presentation of oral allergies
- Understanding the link between dry mouth burning mouth and altered taste
- Be able to distinguish the symptom of burning and its possible causes from burning mouth syndrome
- Be able to diagnose and manage a patient with a dry mouth
